Introduction

Hawley Lake Sail Training Centre is both a Membership club and a RYA Training centre open to all for sailing and windsurfing. We offer membership to the club with club racing, events and free training sessions such as Novice Race Training, Youth Race Training and Youth Clubs.

Hawley Lake is a popular, friendly sailing club offering a range of benefits to its club members. We have several classes of membership including individual, family and junior membership and offer boat berthing to those with boats, and boat passes to those without.

HLSTC is affiliated to the ASA, however ASA members are not classed as Members automatically. Serving personnel will receive discounts here, however you are advised that Army Sail Training Centres will offer different, often cheaper facilities (due to the differing nature of their funding).

Membership Year

The membership year at HLSTC runs from the 1st March annually. The renewal reminders are sent in February and all renewal slips and payments should be returned within 1 month to avoid a late charge.

Organisation

HLSTC is a self sufficient club open to all. There is a committee which includes several officers from RSME Minley, and elected club members. The club is run on a daily basis by the Principal, Membership Secretary and seasonal instructional / volunteer staff. Our Safety Officers (O.O.Ds) look after the site at weekends. We are soon to be a charitable company limited by guarantee, which will slightly alter the organisation.

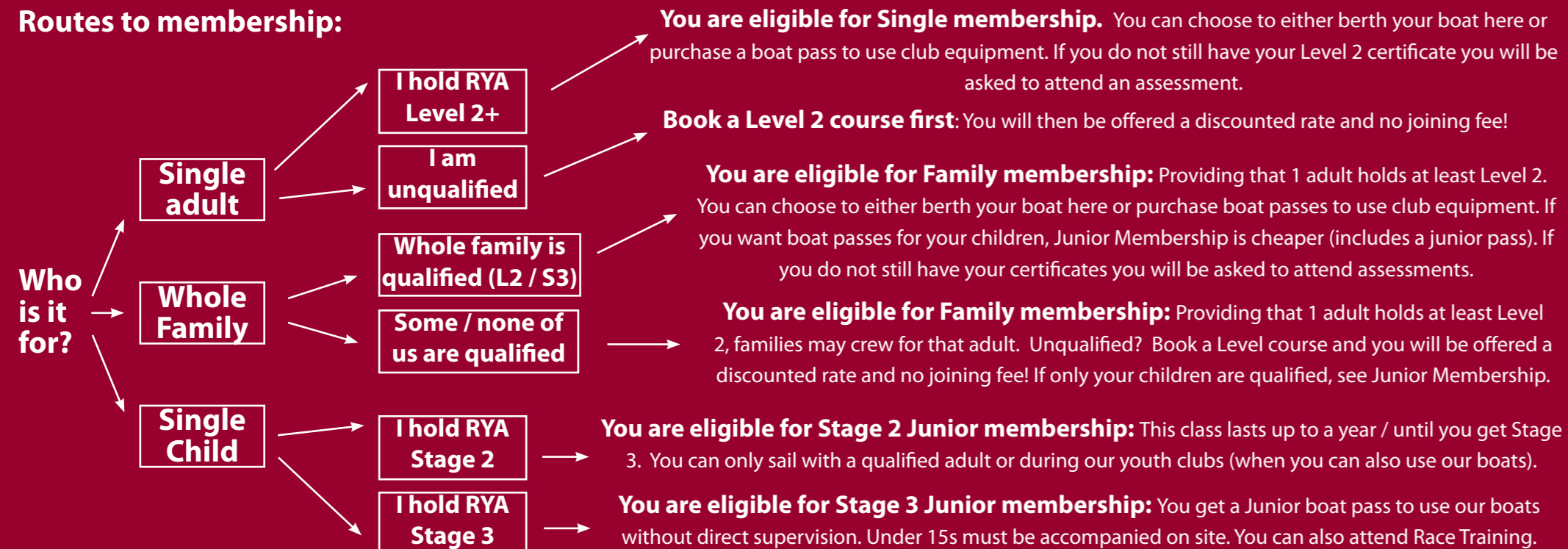
How to apply

1. Once you have decided that you definitely wish to join, complete a Membership Enquiry Questionnaire and send it in to the Centre Principal.
2. The Committee will consider your initial enquiry and decide whether to offer membership. We will then ask for you to submit an application along with your qualifications and the subscription fees.
3. We will send your card(s) to you and arrange for a familiarity session at the club.
4. Join the Member's Forum to keep up to date.

Communication and Information

Our web-site holds lots of useful information about membership and also has the forms for application. Once you become a member, we ask that you join the Forum and subscribe to our topics so that you are kept up to date with important notices. We communicate largely by e-mail, so it is very important that you give us a current e-mail address that you check on a regular basis. Please be patient if you are trying to phone us, we do not employ a receptionist and we are sometimes working outside or teaching on the water! Sending an e-mail is often more successful.

Events

The main event of the year for members is the Club Fun Day which usually takes place in June. On this day, regardless of which class of membership you take out, you may use any of the club's equipment including the sailing, windsurfing and kayaking equipment. We also organise demos boats and there are mini races and activities such as the popular Raft Building Race. There are activities for children and you can sign up for a free taster session in sailing, windsurfing or kayaking. This year the Fun Day will be held on 9th June 2012.

We have other events throughout the year such as special races, quiz nights, charity events and parties such as the New Years Eve Ball and the Summer Beach Party. All of the events are suggested and run by volunteer members with the direction of Committee Members. If you would like to help you are very welcome to join us! Events are open to members only, occasionally guests may attend for a small charge.

Discounts

As a HLSTC member you receive discounts on all of our RYA courses and on Club Hire. We only offer discounts to named members (ie as a family member only those listed on our system will be eligible for discounts).

Free Racing, Free Race Tuition and Free Youth Club.

There is no additional charge to race with us, and we actively encourage all members to join in! We race every Sunday throughout the year and in Summer every Friday evening too. We also have novice race series for those new to racing / sailing and FREE racing tuition.

For our youth sailors we have a Youth Series and again, FREE racing tuition. We are also due to become a Volvo Champion Club, which means that we have lots of great kit, well qualified instructors and a commitment to helping our youths into the British Youth Squads. There will be a supervised Youth Club on Monday evenings during the Summer and there is the annual Youth Regatta (8th September 2012).
